

Fortigen Injectable Solution

10% Gentamycin

Definition:

It is a colorless or cream-colored injectable solution which includes Gentamycin sulphate.

Composition:

Each ml contains 100 mg Gentamycin base (as sulphate)

Indications:

Fortigen is indicated in the treatment of respiratory, digestive, urogenital system infections and also in the septisemia and other soft tissue infections of cattle, horse, dog and cat.

Dosage and administration:

Fortigen is administered by intramuscular (IM) and subcutaneous (SC) route in cattle, horse, dog and cat. Cattle and horse 4 mg/kg/day, cat and dog 4-5 mg/kg/day. According to that, 1 ml for every 25 kg body weight of cattle and horse, 0,1 ml for every 2 kg body weight of dog and cat.

Treatment, which will be 2-3 days in total, should begin with half a dosage in the first day but full dosage in the following days.

It mustn't be applied over dosage. Must be careful about dosage especially for weak and small animals.

Packing:

50 and 100 ml glass vials in cardboard box.
