Oral Solution

Florfenicol

Definition:

It is a clear yellow-coloured oral solution which includes Florfenicol .

Composition:

Contains per ml:
Florfenicol 100 mg.
Solvents ad 1 ml.

Indications:

FlorenOral is indicated for preventive and therapeutic treatment of gastrointestinal and respiratory tract infections, caused by florfenicol sensitive micro-organisms such as Actinobaccillus spp. Pasteurella spp. Salmonella spp. and Streptococcus spp. in swine and poultry. The presence of the disease in the herd should be established before preventive treatment. Medication should be initiated promptly when respiratory disease is diagnosed.

Dosage and administration:

For oral administration. The appropriate final dosage should be based on the daily water consumption.
Swine: 1 litre per 1000 litres of drinking water (100 ppm; 10 mg/kg body weight) for 5 days.
Poultry: 1 litre per 1000 litres of drinking water (100 ppm; 10 mg/kg body weight) for 3 days.

Packing:

Bottle of 500 and 1000 ml.
