

Corusun Oral Solution

2.5% Enrofloxacin

Definition:

It is a clear yellow-colored oral solution which includes Enrofloxacin.

Composition:

Each ml contains; 25 mg Enrofloxacin base.

Indications:

Corusun is indicated in the treatment of infections caused by Gram (+) and Gram (-) bacteria which are sensitive to enrofloxacin and mycoplasma infections on lambs and calves which rumination haven't started yet. A major use is for respiratory and digestive system infections like pasteurellosis, salmonellosis, mycoplasmosis, colibacillosis and colisepticemia and seconder complications of viral infections.

Dosage and administration:

Corusun is administered orally with a dosage of 2.5 mg/kg live weight/day for 3 days. It may be applied 5 mg/kg live weight/day for 5 days for treatment of Salmonellosis and severe respiratory system infections. Practical dosage is; 1 ml/ 10 kg live weight/day. For severe respiratory system infections or pasteurellosis and salmonellosis infections it is 2 ml/ 10 kg live weight/day. Pump gives 1 ml solution everytime it is pushed. In the process application the pump is placed into the mouth of the animal and pumped according to the needed dosage.

Packing:

Plastic bottle of 100 ml in cardboard box with a pump inside.
