

Floksin Oral

20% Enrofloxacin

Definition:

It is a clear, pale yellow-coloured oral solution which includes Enrofloxacin.

Composition:

Each ml contains; 200 mg Enrofloxacin.

Indications:

Floksin is indicated in the treatment of infections caused by bacteria which are sensitive to enrofloxacin and mycoplasma in chickens. A major use of Floksin is for the treatment of mycoplasmal infections (CRD), colibacillosis, pasteurellosis, salmonellosis and staphylococcosis in broilers.

Dosage and administration:

For oral administration:

Calves, goats and sheep: Twice daily 5ml per 75-150 kg

body weight for 3-5 days. Poultry: 1 litre per 3000-4000litres of drinking water for

3-5 davs. Swine: 1 litre per 2000-6000 litres of drinking water for

3-5 days.

Note: for pre-ruminant calves, lambs and kids only.
