# Poultris Oral Suspansion

Trimethoprim + Sulfamethoxazole



# Definition:

It is an off white-yellow coloured oral suspansion which includes Trimethoprim and Sulfamethoxazole.

## Composition:

Each ml contains 80 mg Trimethoprim and 400 mg

### Indications:

Poultris is indicated in the treatment of infections caused by sensitive Gram (+) and Gram (-) bacteria on broiler, turkey, calf and also on lamb and kid which rumen activity haven't started yet.

For broiler and turkey; Coliseptisemia, salphingitis, cholera, coryza and staphylococ infections and other infections which are caused by the sensitive bacteria.

For calf, lamb and kids; Bacterial diarrhoea, gastro-enteritis, coliseptisemia, broncho-pneumonia, calf diphtheria,

inflammation of umbilical cord, secondary bacterial infections

## Dosage and administration:

caused by viral infections.

Poultris is added in clean drinking water.
Combine pharmacologic dosage of Poultris is 16-32 mg/ kg total
weight/day. (trimethoprim 80 mg/ml +
sulfametoxazole 400 mg/ml, total 480 mg/ml).
Dosage should be used 1-2 times a day for 3-5 days.
Practically; for hen and turkey for which collective treatment is
needed 15-30 ml/ 450 kg total weight/day for 3-5
days is sufficient.
For calf, lamb and kids which rumen activity haven't started yet,
0,5-1 ml/15 kg total weight/day for 3-5 days is

sufficent. It is recommended to divide the daily dosage into two.

Packing:

200 ml glass bottles in cardboard box and 1 lt. plastic bottle without cardboard box,
