Injectable Solution

1% Ivermectin

Definition:

It is a clear and pale yellow coloured injectable solution which includes Ivermectin.

Composition:

Each ml contains 10 mg Ivermectin.

Indications:

Iversin Injectable Solution is an endectosid that used for the treatment and control of clinical and subclinical infection and infestation which are caused by endo and ectoparasites of cattle and sheep. Iversin is used as a wide-range effective endectosid against mature and immature forms of parasites.

Dosage and administration:

Iversin's pharmacologic dosage is of 0,2 mg/kg of live weight and it should be administered subcutaneously (SC). It is injected to shoulder (preferably to the front or back of the shoulder) in cattle and to the hairless region of armpit in sheep subcutaneously (SC). The dosage should be 1 ml/50 kg live weight for cattle and 0.5 ml/25 kg live weight for sheep.

For volumes higher than 10 ml, the dosage should be divided into two.

Packing:

50 and 100 ml glass vials in cardboard box.
