



Floksin

Injectable Solution

10% Enrofloxacin

Definition:

It is a pale yellow-coloured, clear injectable solution which includes Enrofloxacin.

Composition:

Each ml contains; 100 mg Enrofloxacin.

Indications:

Floksin is indicated in the treatment of respiratory, digestive and urogenital infections of cattle and sheep, which are caused by Gram (+) and Gram (-) bacteria. In addition to that Floksin can be used for the soft tissue infections' systematic treatment.

Dosage and administration:

Daily treatment dosage of Enrofloxacin is 2.5 mg/kg of body weight for cattle and sheep, can be administered via intramuscularly (IM), subcutaneous (SC) or intravenous (IV) route.

Cattle: 2.5 ml/100 kg b.w.

Sheep: 1 ml/40 kg of b.w.

Administered for 3 days. Recommended to administrate 5 mg/kg for 5 days in the cases of Salmonellosis and chronic infections.

It musn't apply on the same injection area if the dosage is over 5 ml for sheep, 10 ml for cattle. In the administration antisepsis should be followed.

Packing:

20, 50 and 100 ml glass vials in cardboard box.
