

Galtris Injectable Solution

Trimethoprim + Sulfamethoxazole

Definition:

It is a clear yellow-coloured injectable solution which includes Trimethoprim and Sulfamethoxazole.

Composition:

Each ml contains 40 mg Trimethoprim and 200 mg Sulfamethoxazole.

Indications:

Galtris is indicated in respiratory system infections (pneumonias caused by Pasteurella, enzootic pneumonie, farengitis, tonsillitis, bronchitis, broncho-pneumonia, pleuritis) digestive system infections (infections caused by E.coli and Salmonella spp., gastritis, enteritis, gastro-enteritis), urogenital system infections (nephritis, pyelonephritis, vaginitis, pyometra), other soft tissue infections and secondary bacterial complications of viral infections of cattle, horse and dog.

Dosage and administration:

Galtris is administered intramuscularly (IM) or by slow intravenous (IV) injection. It is recommended to administer intravenously (IV) on horse and dog. Must be avoid of subcutaneous injection because of local reaction in all species.

Dosage is 15-30 mg/ kg live weight. Practically; 1 ml Galtris / 10 -15 kg live weight a day is sufficient.

Packing:

50 and 100 ml glass vials in cardboard box.
